MATHEMATICAL UNDERSTANDING

In Maths we will be following the White Rose schemes of work.

During the term we will cover; shape, position and direction, decimals and units of measurement.

Times Tables and Mathletics will continue to be a focus.

We will also continue our fluency sessions to recap previous learning.

COMPUTING

We will finish our unit on becoming architects using 2D and 3D CAD software.

We will then become web developers.

Internet Safety will continue to be a priority.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

1. Life in the Risen Jesus – In this topic the children will understand the Jesus is risen from the dead and is present to us in different ways. They will hear the story of Jesus appearance to Mary of Magdala. They will have an opportunity to learn about different ways of praying and Jesus' teaching and example of prayer.

2. People of Other Faiths - In this topic the children will learn about some of the similarities and differences that exist between Christianity and other world faiths. They will have an opportunity to learn about beliefs, behaviour, and places of worship.

SCIENCE

In science, we will be looking at living things and their habitats and animals including humans where we will focus on life cycles of different classifications of animals and how they vary.

This includes the life cycle of humans and what changes we go through as we grow older.

HUMANITIES

In history, we will look at an overview of the earliest civilisations, focusing on Ancient Egypt including their religion and achievements.



THE ARTS AND DT

In art, we will be looking at digital design including Bauhaus. We will apply learning to create a book cover including typography.

In DT, we will be creating our own pizza recipes.

In music, we will learn rhythms and dances from south and west Africa and create our own compositions.

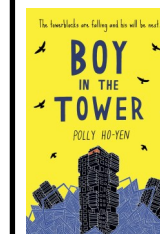
WELL BEING

PE this half term will be athletics and rounders. Next half term it will be cricket and tennis. PE days are Wednesdays and Fridays.

In PHSE, we will look at relationships and 'Changing Me' including how boys and girls bodies change.

ENGLISH AND READING

In Reading sessions, we will be continuing with 'Stig of the Dump' by Clive King and practise comprehension on unseen texts.



In English lessons, we will begin by writing a suspense story based on The Boy in the Tower by Polly Ho-Yen.

We will then study information texts using the Lost Book of Adventure.



After the Half Term, we will be learning about persuasive adverts and free verse poetry.

Our spellings will be silent letters, unstressed vowels, apostrophes, hyphens and homophones.
