SRPING TERM YEAR 3

MATHEMATICAL UNDERSTANDING

We continue to use the WHITE ROSE scheme of work.

Multiplication and Division – We will aim to master the 3, 4 and 8 times table whilst the children will explore what it means to 'multiply' and 'divide'. They will also begin to multiply 2 and 3 digit numbers by a 1 digit number using a formal written method.

Measurement (length & perimeter; mass and capacity) - This will be a very practical unit of learning where the children will explore lengths (m, cm, mm) and perimeter. They will also begin to convert between measurements. They will repeat these skills with mass and capacity.

Fractions - The children will learn about unit and non-unit fractions including ordering, comparing and finding basic equivalent fractions using a fraction wall. They will learn about the whole and how fractions link to this.

COMPUTING

In this half term we will be working on our presenting skills with lots of video work in groups.

After half term, we will be learning about computer networks.



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

In RE our first topic is 'The Sacrament of Reconciliation' where we will learn about sin and how to say sorry.



After half term, we will celebrate and learn about mass and why it is so important, including first communion for those that are taking it.

SCIENCE

In this half term we will be learning about rocks and soils. We will be investigating different rocks and soils and performing experiments with them.



Next half term we will continue working with soils but with a focus on plants and the function of different parts.

THE ARTS AND DT

This half term we will be finishing our sandwich project before moving onto colour mixing and 3D sculpture using volcanoes as a stimulus.



After half term, we will look at shell structures including some Computer Aided Design programs.



In music, we will learn about pentatonic melodies and composition before starting rehearsals on our Easter play.

HUMANITIES

Linked to our science, we will be studying volcanoes and earthquakes in Geography with a focus on Naples and Campania. We will discuss how a volcano is formed, the different parts of volcanoes and plate tectonics. We will focus on areas of Italy and Mount Vesuvius.

After half term, we will be looking at the history and geography of Ware and what makes it such a great town to live in!



WELL BEING

PE this half term will be netball and gym. Next half term it will be handball and dance. PE days are Mondays and Fridays.

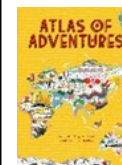
In PHSE, we will be looking at relationships and celebrating differences.

ENGLISH AND READING

We will begin this term by writing a non-chronological report based on The Atlas of Adventures. This will include captions and labels, Index, Glossary A-Z guide

We will also be writing a narrative extract based on Alice in Wonderland and a persuasive speech using Stella and the Seagull.



After half term, we will be writing some personal narratives and looking at calligrams.

Our grammar and punctuation focuses will be adverbs, prepositions, extending sentences with more than one clause, apostrophes for omission and singular possession and the present perfect tense

Our reciprocal reading book this term will be Charlotte's Web by EB White.



Our spellings will be word endings and suffixes.
