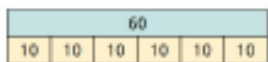
CURRICULUM MAP SPRING TERM YEAR 2

MATHEMATICAL UNDERSTANDING

We continue to use the WHITE ROSE scheme of work.

Throughout this half term we will be focusing on place value and learning them by recall number facts. We can then use these patterns and apply them to adding 1 digit numbers to 2 digit numbers up to 100. We will then progress this skill onto bridging through ten to add and subtract.

In multiplication the children will learn the 2,5,10 multiplication and division facts through repeated addition and subtraction. These skills will then be applied to money and problem solving tasks.

$60 \div \square = 10$



COMPUTING

In Spring 1, the children will be exploring "photographs." The children will focus on the skills needed to take a good photograph, learn about cameras and use Picasa to sort and edit their photographs.



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

We will be continue to follow the RED Re scheme. Starting in Spring 1 with Galilee to Jerusalem (Jesus' baptism). We will deepen their knowledge from Year One about who Jesus is and understand how he teaches about the nature of God through parables and miracles. In Spring 2, we will be learning about Desert to garden (Holy Week). Year Two will revisit scripture from the previous year to consolidate learning about the events of Holy Week.

SCIENCE

In Spring 1 we will be continuing to look at animals and humans, describing the basic needs of animals including humans for survival. In Spring 2 we will be exploring Living things and habitats as well as going to Waltham Abby Gardens for a discovery day.



HUMANITIES

In Spring 1 Year 2 will be learning about hospitals and nurses from the past including Mary Seacole, Florence Nightingale and Edith Cavell.



In Spring 2 children will be answering if they would prefer to live in a hot or cold place linked to geography.

THE ARTS AND DT

We will start the term looking at moving wheels in DT. Followed by art, where we will explore Natascha Maksimovic printing.



In music children will use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes, experiment with, create, select and combine sounds using the inter-related dimensions of music and play tuned and untuned instruments musically.

WELL BEING

This term we are looking at our dreams and goals and to identify what their realistic goals are and how they can be achieved. In Spring 2, we will be understanding what contributes a healthy lifestyle, including physical activity, dental health and healthy eating in our topic "Healthy Me". IN RSE, we will be exploring emotions and well-being.

PE days this term will be Wednesday and Thursday, but please could your child's PE kit continue to be in school each day. In Spring 2, year 2 will be going swimming.



ENGLISH AND READING

We will start Spring 2 looking at list poems focusing on *The Puffin Book of Fantastic First Poems* selected by June Crebbin.

We will also be writing a narrative extract based on *Rapunzel* by Bethan Woolvin and a non-chronological report using *Say Hi to Hedgehogs* by Jane McGuinness and *Big Blue Whale* by Nicola Davies.



After half term, we will be writing narratives based on real experiences and looking at poetry further.

Our grammar and punctuation focus throughout the Spring term will be understanding sentences with different forms (command, statement, exclamation and question), using suffixes -ful and -less, using expanded noun phrases to add detail to writing and using conjunctions correctly to join 2 clauses together.

We will be continuing to focus on reading in our guided reading groups. Please ensure you continue reading with your child at home and use the questions at the front of your child's homework diary to support their comprehension.
