

## Spring term homework projects

<p><b>History</b></p> <p>We will be learning about the role of nurses in history, particularly focusing on key historical figures, how nurses worked in the past, and how nursing has evolved over time.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Research and create a short biography of a famous nurse from history</li><li>• Create a visual comparison of what nurses wore in the past versus what nurses wear today.</li><li>• Create a simple "nurse's kit" using craft supplies.</li></ul>	<p>Due Friday 30<sup>th</sup> January 2026</p>
<p><b>Art</b></p> <p>We will be learning about Natascha Maksimovic and her printing. Children could:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Make a mini marbling print (using water and safe paints) and write 2–3 sentences describing how they made it.</li><li>• Draw their own marbled pattern using crayons or felt tips and label it with two describing words (e.g., “swirly”, “flowing”).</li><li>• Look at an example of marbled art and write down three colours and one pattern they notice.</li><li>• Create a “marbled wallpaper” design in a small square and write one sentence about what inspired their design.</li></ul>	<p>Due Friday 27<sup>th</sup> February 2026</p>
