MATHEMATICAL UNDERSTANDING

In Maths we will be following the White Rose schemes of work.

During the term we will cover; Multiplication and Division, Perimeter and Area, Fractions, and Decimals and Percentages.

Times Tables and Mathletics will continue to be a focus.

We will also continue our fluency sessions to recap multiplication skills.

COMPUTING

We will become architects and create 2D and 3D models digitally using computer aided design (CAD).

Internet Safety will continue to be a priority.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

GALILEE TO JERUSALEM Pupils will explore the 'new law' given by Jesus, his summary of the law of Moses, and the transfiguration of the Jesus, where the disciples Peter, James and John see him accompanied by Elijah, the greatest of the prophets and Moses, the giver of the Law.

DESERT TO GARDEN Pupils will explore the meaning of these words by exploring what it means to sin and the last things, death, judgement, heaven, and hell as part of God's plan for salvation. God's plan is for everyone to go to heaven .

SCIENCE

Children will start grouping materials by their properties and then look at reversible and irreversible changes as well as solutions and separating materials.

Towards the end of term, our work will be focused on science week and investigative skills.

THE ARTS AND DT



This half term we will be using colour and shape create a piece of art based on the Bauhaus movement.



In music, we will finish The Blues before moving onto composition notation using the theme of the Ancient Egyptians.

After half term, we will be learning songs for the Hertford and Ware Schools Music Festival cantata, *The Journey*.

HUMANITIES

In history, we will look at an overview of the earliest civilisations, focusing on Ancient Egypt including their religion and achievements.



After the half term, we will be learning about rivers and completing geographical fieldwork. This will involve our trip to Epping Forest.

WELL BEING

PE this half term will be gymnastics and Outdoor and Adventurous activities. Next half term it will be health related exercise and netball. PE days are Wednesdays and Thursdays.

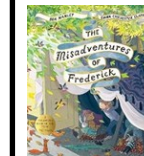
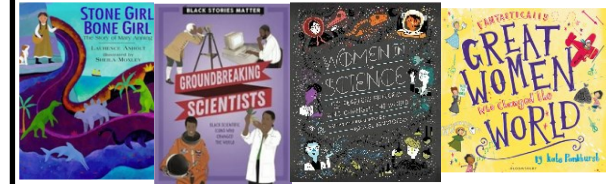
In PHSE, we will be looking at puberty and body changes and 'Healthy Me'.
