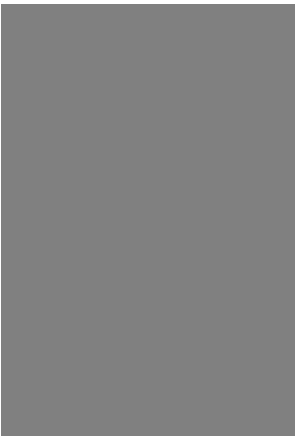


YEAR 6

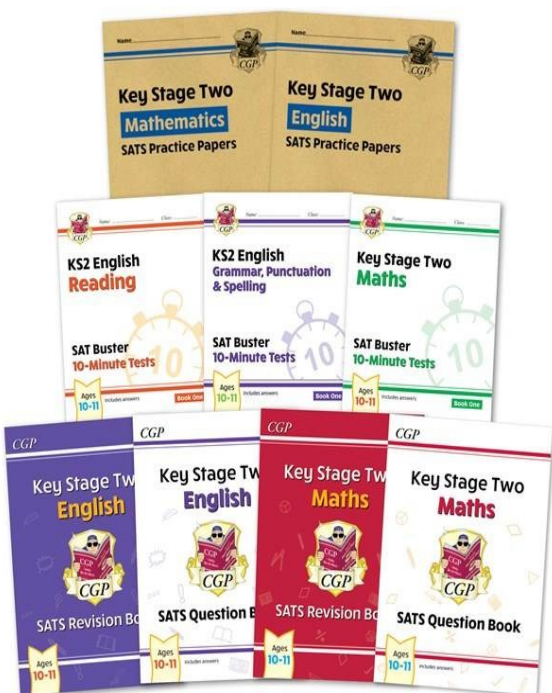
Every week each group is presented with £5 - £50 pounds [in fake money] to go towards a fun and well deserved activity.
