CURRICULUM MAP

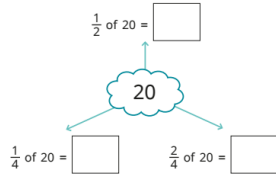
SUMMER TERM YEAR 2



MATHEMATICAL UNDERSTANDING

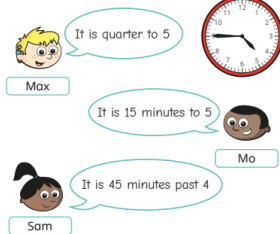
We continue to use the WHITE ROSE scheme of work. Throughout this term we will be focusing on number fluency, with a particular focus on addition and subtraction.

In summer 1, we will be learning measurement about fractions. Focusing on half, quarter and thirds.



Children will recognise that 2/4 and 1/2 are equivalent and write simple fractions. As well as find, recognise, write and name fractions 1/3, 1/4, 2/4 and 3/4 as being a part of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity.

We will also learn how to tell the time. In year 2 children will tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times. As well as know the number of minutes in



COMPUTING

The first topic is 'We are Researchers'. Children will retrieve digital content from the Internet for a particular purpose and use mind mapping software to organise their questions and answers about a topic.



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

We start the term with branch 5 'To the Ends of the Earth.' In this branch children explore the Ascension and Pentecost to deepen their understanding of the Holy Spirit as the 'quiet guest of our soul', as described by St Augustine. They explore how the Holy Spirit transforms people, both inwardly and outwardly, through the gifts and fruits of the Spirit. In Summer 2, 'Dialogue & Encounter' children reflect on the command to love others as a way of loving God, beginning with the parable of the Good Samaritan. In the encounter dimension, pupils deepen their understanding of Judaism by linking a Torah teaching to Jewish life today, such as keeping the Sabbath or following kosher food laws.



SCIENCE

Next term, the Year 2 class will study "Plants". In this topic, children will learn how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants by observing their development. They will also explore what plants need to stay healthy, including water, light, and a suitable temperature.



HUMANITIES

During the first half of this term we will be looking at The Great Fire of London. We also will visit Mill Green Museum for a workshop. In Summer 2, children will explore the Serekunda, focusing on The Gambia in Africa.



THE ARTS AND DT

To start the term we will be making our salads we planned from last term. After, we will be exploring paint skills. In the second half of the term, in DT, we will be making 3D structures.



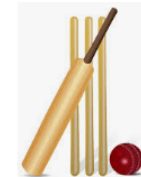
In music, we will be focusing on Myths and Legends. Creating rhythms and arrange them in a particular order or structure.



WELL BEING

This term we will be looking at relationships and keeping safe. In summer 2 we will be exploring how we change.

PE days this term will be Monday and Thursday, but please ensure your child's PE kit is in school everyday in case these change. We also will be having many enrichment activities including sports day.



ENGLISH AND READING

Throughout, the term we will be writing instructions based on A Beginner's Guide to Bear Spotting and How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth (both written by Michelle Robinson) and then going onto narratives based on 'The Lost Homework' by Richard O'Neill,



After half term we will be writing a recount, narrative and poems.

Our grammar and punctuation focus throughout the summer term will be knowing the four types of sentence: statements, questions, exclamations and commands, using the progressive form of verbs in the present and past tense and using the present tense and past tense correctly and consistently.

In reading we will be looking at a variety of extracts focusing on comprehension and inference questions.
