CURRICULUM MAP

SUMMER TERM YEAR 3



MATHEMATICAL UNDERSTANDING

We continue to use the WHITE ROSE scheme of work.

Fractions - The children have learnt about unit and non-unit fractions including ordering, comparing and finding basic equivalent fractions using a fraction wall. They will now move on to learning about adding and subtracting fractions and finding fractions of sets of objects.

Money and Measure— The children will be finding change as well as adding and subtracting money. They will do lots of work on time including reading to the nearest minute and finding durations.

Shape— the children will work on both 2D and 3D shapes as well as angles and the direction of lines.

Statistics— collecting and interpreting data, drawing and interpreting bar charts and pictograms.

COMPUTING

In this half term we will be working on writing our own wikis while staying safe online. After half term, we will be writing surveys, collecting and analysing the data.



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

In RE our first topic is '**To the Ends of the Earth**'. We will be focusing on the work of the disciples in the Acts and that Paul wrote letters to the early Christian communities. We will also use religious language to describe the Christian belief in the mystery of God as Trinity and describe some signs and symbols of the Holy Trinity. After half term, our focus will be '**Dialogue and Encounter**'. We will be making links between Exodus and the account of the Last Supper and simply describe how Jewish people celebrate the Passover in Britain today. We will make links with the Exodus account, correctly using specialist vocabulary to describe symbols and actions in the meal.

SCIENCE

We will be looking at the function of different parts of a flowering plant, what they need to germinate and thrive and their life cycle.



After half term, we will study animals including humans. Focusing on skeletons, muscles and nutrition.

HUMANITIES

We will be studying the Romans in Britain including why they invaded, how they changed the country and landscape and their legacy. We will be enriching this with a trip to Colchester Castle Museum. After half term, we will be learning what makes Catalonia a unique place to live, and how does its geography influence the way people live and work?

THE ARTS AND DT

This half term we will be finishing

After half term, we will move to art and will be drawing and sculpting fish. Looking at the work of Dorell Wakelam.

In music after half term, we will continue our instrumental lessons on the recorder with some added percussion to jazz it up!

WELL BEING

PE this half term will be swimming and athletics. Next half term it will be tennis and rounders. PE days are Thursday (swimming) and Friday but will change after half term.

In PHSE, we will be looking at Dreams and Goals and Changing Me after half term.

In SRE (Live life to the full), we will look at our own bodies, the church community and the meaning of love.

ENGLISH AND READING

We will be writing persuasive speech and letters using Speak Up! Clean Up! Look Up! (all written by Nathan Bryon).



After half term, we will be writing instructions, a narrative based on The Iron Man and reading the poetry of Joseph Coelho.



Our grammar and punctuation focuses will be paragraphs, adverbs, prepositions, extending sentences with more than one clause, apostrophes for omission and singular possession and the present perfect tense

Our reciprocal reading book this term will be Charlotte's Web by E.B. White.



Our spellings will be suffixes and prefixes as well as some trickier vowel graphemes.
