MATHEMATICAL UNDERSTANDING

Our Mathematics is based on the White Rose scheme of learning. It will develop the children’s foundational knowledge of skills as well as improving their problem solving skills. This term we will study:

Decimals: The children will consolidate their knowledge of decimal place value as well as dividing two-digit decimals. We will then continue with decimals learning how to partition, compare, order and round them.

Statistics: The children will explore a range of different types of data creating charts, interpreting lines graphs and understanding pictograms.

Decimals: We will explore money converting between pounds and pence. We will solve money based problems before estimating amounts.

Time: The children will look at telling the time on digital and analogues clocks, solving time-related word problems and converting to 24 hour clock.

Times tables: We will practice all our tables weekly in preparation for the upcoming tables

COMPUTING

This term we will be working on creating a ‘wiki’ as well as exploring how computers are used to predict the weather.



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

In RE our first topic is ‘Ends of the Earthy’ where we will focus on Peter’s mission and the early Church. After half ter, we will begin ‘Dialogue and Encounter.’ We will reflect on St Paul as well as the pillars of Islam.



SCIENCE

The first unit of Summer term will be electricity including; how to build a working circuit.; insulation and switches



After half term, we will look at ‘Living Things’ focussing on different groups and classification.

HUMANITIES

In History, we will focus on a range of ancient civilisations. We will focus on key aspects such as writing, mathematics and technology



In Geography, we will trial a new unit on food from around the world.

THE ARTS AND DT

In Art, we will explore different techniques for landscape painting. After this, we will move onto DT and use programming to control electrical circuits.

In music, we will look be looking at carnival and samba rhythms.



WELL BEING

PE this half term will be athletics and rounders. PE days are Mondays and Wednesdays. Next half term it will be tennis and swimming. PE days will then change to Wednesday and Thursday.

In PHSE, we will be looking at ‘Relationships’ and ‘Changes.’

In SRE, we will look at the units on ‘life cycles.’ and ‘puberty.’

ENGLISH AND READING

We will begin this term by writing a piece of persuasion based on two key texts: Greta’ and the Giants’ and ‘Malala’s Magic Pencil.’ We will look at organisational features and persuasive techniques before producing our own persuasive presentations. After this, we will look at writing our own poetry.

After half term, we will again practise narrative writing based on the story ‘The Girl who Stole and Elephant’ before writing a factual report on play.



Our grammar and punctuation focuses will be use of accurate punctuation including commas and inverted clauses and inverted commas. Spellings will be sent home weekly.

Our reciprocal reading book this term will be ‘Beowulf’ retold by Michael Morpurgo. We will also look at topic themed reading comprehensions.

We will be describing likes and dislikes.
