MATHEMATICAL UNDERSTANDING

We continue to use the WHITE ROSE scheme of work.

The children will explore counting both forwards and backwards in 2s, 5s and 10s. The children will then begin by using stories that link to pictures and concrete resources to help support them in recognising equal groups.

COMPUTING

In this unit, the children will create a talking book that they can share with others. This unit will enable the children to: use sound recording equipment to record sounds and develop skills in saving and storing sounds.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

This topic is designed to develop children’s knowledge and understanding of the Resurrection of Jesus and its message. The children will learn that Easter is the most important Christian feast because Jesus rose from the dead on Easter Sunday. They will learn about the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost and reflect on times when their own sadness turned to joy. They will be introduced to Thomas the apostle and reflect on the importance of his story.

SCIENCE

Animals including Humans
The children will identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense. Children will classify animals into the animal groups.

Art

The children will be experimenting with and using found materials to create a range of linear visual effects. They will then explore the concept of hot and cold colours. Through out the unit the children will be discussing their own work and that of others and developing images in response to the comments.

HUMANITIES

Geography The Isles of Scilly

In this unit the children learn to locate the Isle of Scilly. They will use geographical language to describe the physical and human features. They will find out how to give simple compass directions using the four cardinal points of the compass.

ENGLISH AND READING

In Summer 1 we revisit our understanding of writing letters through the book Paddington’s Post by Michael Bond. In this unit the children will focus on using capital letters and full stops.

We will start our next Narrative unit ,featuring Little Red and the Hungry Lion by Alex Smith. During this unit the children will innovate the story so that they change the settings and main characters. The children will focus on beginning to use capital letters and connecting ideas using ‘because’. We will also begin to explore different sentence types by punctuating sentences with full stops, exclamation marks and question marks.

We then finish Summer 1 with a Poetry unit featuring “Out and About: A First Book of Poems’ by Shirley Hughes. During this unit the children will revisit writing a free verse poem.
